

Certified Animal Cruelty Investigator Course Bergen Community College Saturdays, June 3 through July 22

Bergen Community College is offering the *Animal Cruelty Investigator Course* approved by the New Jersey Department of Health and the New Jersey Police Training Commission. Over the course of seven (7) classroom days you will have to opportunity to be taught by, interact with, and build relationships with six (6) of the foremost experts in the State of New Jersey regarding Animal Cruelty (the following is a link to the biographies of the faculty instructing in this class http://www.cditraining.org/pages/ACIfaculty.html.

Anyone wishing to understand the issue of animal cruelty, the animal cruelty laws; and, their enforcement may and should attend this course. Successful completion of this course is required for appointment as an Animal Cruelty Investigator by a New Jersey Municipality and meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 8:23A-2.6.

Enrollment is open to any person 18 years of age or older. While enrollment is limited we hope to accommodate all applicants.

The course will be held on seven Saturdays, between June 3 through July 22, 2017 (with no class on July 1). Classes will be held from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm each day. The dress code for this class is business casual. Completion of the course requires attendance at all classes. Tuition for this seven-day program is \$879, which includes all materials.
