This training is mandated under N.J.SA. 4:22-11.11 for all SPCA personnel in NJ.

The course will be held at the BERGEN COUNTY LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY INSTITUTE on nine Saturdays, February 23 to April 27, 2013 from 9:00AM to 5:00PM. There will be no class on Saturday, March 30.

Applicants must be currently affiliated with the County or State NJSPCA.

Each applicant must have a letter from the appointing authority / prosecutor's office stating their title classification, Humane Law Enforcement Officer or Humane Law Enforcement Agent. This letter must be in compliance with NJSA 4:22-11.7e. This letter must be presented on the first day of class or the officer will not be allowed to proceed.

The dress code for this class is uniforms or formal dress attire. No Firearms may be carried at the academy.

Completion of the course requires attendance at all classes. Tuition for this program is \$1,000, which includes all materials.
