Anyone wishing to understand the issue of animal cruelty, the animal cruelty laws; and, their enforcement may and should attend this course. Successful completion of this course is required for appointment as an Animal Cruelty Investigator by a New Jersey Municipality and meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 8:23A-2.6.

Enrollment is open to any person 18 years of age or older. While enrollment is limited we hope to accommodate all applicants.

The course will be held on seven Saturdays, from April 16-June 11, 2016. Classes will be held from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm each day. The dress code for this class is business casual. Completion of the course requires attendance at all classes. Tuition for this seven-day program is \$879, which includes all materials.
