



Updated Laws, Investigation and the Courtroom for Health Officers and Registered Environmental Health Specialists

This course is designed for health officers and registered environmental health specialists in New Jersey. This one of a kind program discusses current cases and laws, local ordinances, model ordinances, pending legislation, investigation techniques and enforcement authorities, administrative search warrants, investigative report writing, evidence, court procedures, and techniques for testifying in court.

Dealing with foreclosed properties, quarantine, administrative warrants, chain of custody, types and care of evidence, are also covered among a wide variety of related subjects.
